John Ellison, an Award-Winning musician, emerged onto the music scene in the mid-1960s when he connected with the original members of the Soul Brothers Five in Rochester, New York. Joining as the sixth member, Ellison's arrival prompted the band to rebrand as the Soul Brothers Six. Alongside Charles Armstrong, Harry Armstrong, Vonnell Benjamin, Lester Pelemon, and Joe Johnson, Ellison signed a recording contract with Atlantic Records, setting the stage for their impactful musical journey.

As the lead guitarist, singer, and songwriter of the group, Ellison made history during a recording session in Philadelphia in 1967 when he penned "She's Some Kind of Wonderful." This original masterpiece reached number 91 on the US Billboard chart, solidifying the Soul Brothers Six as a major influence on the modern music landscape, as acknowledged by the 1987 book Sweet Soul Music.

The timeless appeal of "She's Some Kind of Wonderful" endured through its use by over 50 different artists, turning it into one of the most recorded songs in music history. In 1995, Ellison received a citation of achievement from Broadcast Music for writing the third-most played song globally.

Post the Soul Brothers Six era, Ellison continued to make significant contributions to the music industry. In 1993, he embarked on a solo career, releasing albums like "Welcome Back" and "Missing You," followed by "Back" in 2007. Ellison's musical journey extended globally, with regular performances at the prestigious Nice Jazz Festival in France with extensive international tours. Tours.


Beyond the stage, Ellison's roots remain deeply connected to his hometown of Kimball, West Virginia. In July 2013, a project near his childhood home saw the clearing of land for a museum dedicated to Ellison's music and early life in the local mine camp community. This endeavor was part of a service project linked to the 2013 National Boy Scout Jamboree.

In 2020, Ellison released the impactful awareness single "Wake-Up Call (Black Like Me)," garnering acclaim from Rolling Stone and Forbes Magazine. The song's nomination for "Song of the Year 2021" at the Pop Awards underscored its cultural resonance.

Marking his 82nd birthday on August 11, 2023, Ellison released a new rendition of his classic "Some Kind of Wonderful." This version not only earned a Grammy nomination in the American Roots Performance category but also serves as the title track for an album featuring eleven new songs penned by Ellison and produced by Roger Heijster. Scheduled for release on November 10 from PopMi Music, the collection promises to be a testament to Ellison's enduring legacy in the world of music.


